

# Town of Dover Hometown Hero Program



The Town of Dover created the Hometown Hero Program to pay tribute and to honor soldiers who are originally from Dover or who currently reside in Dover and who are active military personnel or veterans that have served this nation in any branch of our Armed Forces.

The Hometown Hero Program is being relaunched to replace the previous banners with new vinyl banners. The fee to purchase a 24" x 38" is \$110. Banners will be displayed in the downtown area from Memorial Day through Veteran's Day for a period of two years with renewal every two years thereafter. The banners will have a photo of the soldier in uniform, their name, and armed service branch, and the era of service placed underneath their photo. Placement of the banners on the street light poles will be chosen via a drawing.

The Hometown Hero Banners reminds all Dover residents and visitors passing through Dover of our hometown heroes that have served or are serving our country, and their sacrifices each have made, deserve our respect and gratitude.
