### **FACILITY USE APPLICATIONS**

Chairman Rodriguez asked if the Dover Recreation Basketball Permits were approved by the Dover Board of Education. Commissioner Fritch stated he received the approval and permits.

#### **SPECIAL EVENTS**

Chairman Rodriguez inquired if judges were set for the Halloween Costume Contest. Superintendent Acevedo stated there were no judges at this time. Suggestions were discussed over who should be asked for judging. Commissioner Fritch asked if a letter could be sent to H.O. Baker asking if they care to participate. Chairman Rodriguez asked if a letter of request could be sent to the Dover Board of Education, Dover Fire Department and Dover Police Department for judges.

Discussion was held in regards to the set-up of the Halloween Parade and Costume Contest at Crescent Field.

Commissioner Gori joined the meeting at 7:26pm.

A suggestion was made to condense the age groups to 4&5 year olds, 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> grade, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade and 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grade. The Commission felt that the condensed age group breakdown would best fit the time frame for the event.

Discussion was held in regards to the purchase and storage of AED machines. Chairman Rodriguez asked Secretary Newkirk to obtain a recommendation from the Dover Fire Department on which type of AED would best serve the sport groups. Chairman Rodriguez suggested to have extra supplies on hand for the AED when purchased. Superintendent Acevedo stated he would look into the budget to see if they can be purchased this year or possibly next year.

Chairman Rodriguez stated to postpone the purchase of the popcorn machine this year so there will be additional funds available for the AED's.
