

CAUCUS MEETING MINUTES February 12, 2008 7:00 PM

The Caucus Meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen was held in council chambers, 37 N. Sussex Street, Dover, New Jersey.

Mayor Dodd called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

All joined in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and prayer was given by Pastor Martinez asking for guidance and strength to do what is right for our people.

SUNSHINE LAW STATEMENT

In accordance with the provisions set forth in the Open Public Meeting Law, notification of this meeting has been sent to all officially designated Town newspapers and notice is posted in the Town Hall.

Mayor Dodd stated the presentation by Certified Valuations, Inc. concerning the revaluation process was canceled due to the inclement weather, and will be rescheduled for the February 26th meeting. He also asked that all reports be held until the next meeting.

Club Colombia Discussion:

Discussion took place concerning Club Colombia's Facility use application to hold the Colombian Festival at Crescent Field. The Recreation Commission referred the application to the Mayor and board for approval.

Mayor Dodd recommended that the application should go back to the Recreation Commission. The use of parks and playgrounds are controlled by the Commission. He asked Attorney Pennella to confirm that. His feelings are that the festival has outgrown the area and strongly suggests another location. Last year there were problems with cooking oil being put in the drains and a lot of garbage left.

Alderman Donofrio asked if there was an appeal process if they were denied by the Commission. Attorney Pennella answered it would have to be done by prerogative writ action to a Superior Court Judge.

Alderwoman Romaine inquired if the County College of Morris was checked as a possible location; she knows other large groups use it.

Alderman Donofrio stated the Hispanic community would like to hold the celebration in town and it might be large.

Alderman Timpani commented that to hold an event at Heddon Park it can't be for more than 200 people.

Mayor Dodd again stated we have to recognize the ability for safety and because of the size he feels they have outgrown Crescent Field.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. The Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.

Mayor Dodd commented he had a meeting with Administrator Garvin and Alderman Visioli concerning the snow and ice removal ordinance. Attorney Pennella drafted an ordinance for the boards review with the main change being the fine amount. The fine was reduced from \$250 to \$50 for first offense, \$150 for second offense and third offense would be \$250 to \$1,250.

Another change provides in the event of non-compliance the code enforcement officer may provide notice to the owner of the property of such non-compliance and the intention within 24 hours of such notice of having the snow and ice removed at the owner's expense.
