RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF DOVER AUTHORIZING THE AMENDMENT OF AN AWARD OF A FAIR AND OPEN PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT TO PRESTIGE ENVIRONMENTAL, INC. FOR THE DPW UNDERGOUND STORAGE TANK REMOVAL AND UPGRADE PROJECT

WHEREAS, on or about October 10, 2017, the Town of Dover awarded a contract for professional services for LSRP for the DPW Underground Storage Tank removal and upgrade project to Prestige Environmental Inc., 220 Davidson Avenue, Suite 307, Somerset, NJ 08873 under a fair and open process, for a one year period, at a cost not to exceed \$420,000.00, unless further authorized by the governing body, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that due to unanticipated costs of labor, the award must be amended by \$75,000 for a new total contract amount of \$495,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Town Administrator recommends that Prestige Environmental, Inc. is qualified to perform this work on behalf of the Town of and recommends the amendment of an award of a contract to Prestige Environmental Inc., 220 Davidson Avenue, Suite 307, Somerset, NJ 08873 under a fair and open process, for a one year period at a cost not to exceed \$495,000.00 unless further authorized by the governing body; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dover authorize the appropriate town officials to enter into an amended contract with Prestige Environmental Inc. for the work described above, for a one year period, at a cost not to exceed \$495,000.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appointment as LSRP for the Town of Dover is made as a professional service under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law; and
