#### **ORDINANCE NO. 11-2011**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF DOVER

AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ARTICLE XXVII OF THE REVISED GENERAL CODE OF THE

TOWN OF DOVER ENTITLED "PARKING" HANDICAPPED PARKING "SPACES"

BY APPROVING A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE AT 19 KING STREET

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dover, County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Said handicap parking space shall be located along the easterly curbline of Guy Street beginning at a point 70 north of the northeasterly curbline intersection of King Street and Guy Street thence, continuing in northerly direction for a distance of 20 feet.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this within ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.

#### ORDINANCE FOR SECOND READING

# ORDINANCE NO. 10-2011 CALENDAR YEAR 2011 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK N.J.S.A. 40a:4-45.14)

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Cap Law, N,J.S.40A"4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final

appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dover in the County of Morris finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2011 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen hereby determines that a 3.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$212,430 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen hereby determine that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dover, in the County of Morris, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2011 budget year, the final appropriations of the Town of Dover shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$495,671 and that the CY 2011 municipal budget for the Town of Dover be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon; be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

**Paula Meyers** – 120 Baker Street – Ms. Meyers complimented the Town of Dover and noted that she is proud to be a resident. She has a concern with the speeding on Baker Street especially because there are many children in the area. Mr. Close noted that the police and engineering departments have reviewed the issue and are comparing notes.
