Minutes of Meeting held: Wednesday, December 8, 2010

The regular monthly meeting of the Honorable Board of Water Commissioners of the Town of Dover was held on the above date at 6:30 p.m., in the Service Building at 100 Princeton Avenue, Dover New Jersey.

The meeting was called to order by President Andrew Du-Jack and he stated that this meeting was in compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act." He then requested all to stand for the "Pledge of Allegiance."

Present: President Andrew Du-Jack and Commissioner Aldo Cicchetti, Also present, Attorney Matt Petracca sitting in for Attorney Peter King, Superintendent, Luis Acevedo and Engineer Andrew Holt.

Copies of the minutes for November14, 2010 were previously received by each of the Commissioners. President Du-Jack then asked if there were any comments/corrections about the minutes. None being noted, Commissioner Aldo Cichetti entertained a motion to accept the minutes, second by President Du-Jack and passed by voice vote. The minutes were then referred to file.

President Du-Jack recognizes Engineer Andrew Holt who proceeds to summarize that he and Luis Acevedo have continue their monthly meetings with Town Administrator William Close. Topics of discussions regarding updating the Water System Procedures Manual by adding the Water Service Area map, Meter Consumption and Pending on changes of the Meter prices and charges which is still under review by the Town of Dover Board of Alderman and Mayor. The main focus for the upcoming months are implementing leak detection and installation of meters in each zone placed on the wells to study which zone uses more water, what time the most consumption is used and the highest spike. Other topics of discussion was the status on the Low service tank 1 bid from U.S. Tank \$ 830,000. Andrew Holt recommends that the bid be rejected and go back out to bid. The upcoming Capital Projects are going to be revisit, ranked and prioritize. Andrew Holt asked if the lead and copper letters have been sent out. Superintendent, Acevedo stated that they did. President, Du-Jack asked if there were any other questions/comments none being noted Commissioner, Cichetti entertained a motion to accept the Engineers report, second by President, Du-Jack and passed by voice vote. Report was referred to file.

President Du-Jack then asked for the Superintendent's Report of Operations and Oral Reports for the month of November. A copy of the monthly report was available to the Commissioners. Superintendent, Acevedo proceeded with some of the items listed on report for the Board.
