

MAYOR CAROLYN BLACKMAN AND THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN ANNOUNCE THE FREE COVID HEALTH FAIR FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

As a part of the Blackman administration's ongoing comprehensive plan to combat COVID-19, on Saturday, November 28, 2020, the Town is hosting a free COVID Health Fair from 9:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. located at Dover High School 100 Grace Street, Dover, New Jersey. Residents of Dover, Wharton, and Mine Hill are all welcome to attend.

Any individual with health insurance must provide their insurance identification card for submission to the insurance company. However, there will be no balance billing. Any individual without insurance is still eligible for free testing, no one will be turned away. Tests for COVID-19 as well as antibody testing will be provided.

Mayor Blackman stated, "This program is one component of our comprehensive plan to address COVID-19 in our community. Widely available testing is essential to defeating COVID-19. One of the main advantages is to identify those who are asymptomatic, so they can become aware of their infection and quarantine to prevent further spread."
