## **EXCLUSIONS**:

The following types of rubbish, garbage, bulk items, recyclables, and materials are **excluded from collection**:

refrigerators, freezers, appliances, "white goods", demolition debris, yard debris, recyclables, wood/tree waste, concrete, rock, soil, animal carcasses, etc.
