HURRICANE IRENE IMPACTS IN DOVER / UPDATE

DOVER, NJ, AUGUST 29, 2011: Mayor James P. Dodd and the Office of Emergency Management would like to advise residents and travelers that the following roads are still closed in Dover:

- Blackwell Street from Bergen Street to Salem Street
- Essex Street from Blackwell Street to Clinton Street
- River Street
- Mercer Street
- South Salem Street from Oram Drive to East Blackwell Street
- North Salem Street from East Blackwell Street to Richards Ave
- Richards Ave from Passaic Street to Rutan Drive
- Perry Street and Richards Avenue
- Trenton Street and Richards Avenue
- Clinton Street and Pequannock Street
- Route 46 and Hudson Street the Roadway is open one lane in each direction.

We are encouraging residents to please exercise caution when driving through the community over the next few days until all streets are reopened.

Also, there is currently no electric power in the following areas:

- Curtis Street
- Summer Avenue
- Livingston Avenue
- South Highland Avenue
- East Munson Avenue
- Park Avenue
- Davis Avenue
- Baker Street
- Parker Street
- Yale Street
- Baker Avenue

We recognize that those of you without power are struggling to maintain the basic quality of life that we are all accustomed to. I want to assure you that we are in constant contact with JCP&L regarding the situation and the need to restore power as quickly as possible here in Dover. They are working as expeditiously as possible but have given us no timeframe for getting us back on line. I ask for your patience and understanding in this situation as JCP&L works to provide full electric power to our community.
