ORDINANCE NO. 04-2012 ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF DOVER AMENDING CHAPTER 236, LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT, ARTICLE IV, ZONING.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the Town of Dover, County of Morris and state of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1

The Code of the Town of Dover, Chapter 236, LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT Article IV, Zoning. shall be amended as follows to provide for certain uses on floors above and/or below street level.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
