

STREET DEPARTMENT



Responsibilities

The Street Department involves many diverse areas of responsibilities which includes maintaining 36 miles of primary streets and alleys along with 5 municipal parking lots.

In addition, this division's responsibilities include:

- Street maintenance and reconstruction including pothole repair, general concrete repairs and crack sealing
- Street Sweeping
- Snow removal
- Pavement Patching
- Emergency Response (flash flooding, storm damage/clean-up, etc.)
- Fall leaf collection (see information below)
- Tree trimmings and removal
- Street signs, installation and maintenance
- Striping of streets, municipal parking lot spaces, painting curbs and school cross walks
- Municipal parking lot maintenance, pay station kiosks and covers
- Alley maintenance
- Mowing town right-of-ways
- Spring clean-up

Fleet Services

The Street Department also consists of 2 mechanics under the direction of 1 supervisor that maintain the DPW trucks, town vehicles, Dial-A-Ride bus and Police and Fire vehicles.

- Provide maintenance and repair services to all town vehicles operating out of one maintenance shop and in the field
- The Mechanics shop is a full service maintenance and repair operation, including:
 - Preventive maintenance
 - Automotive/light truck mechanics
 - Medium and heavy duty truck
 - Off road/heavy equipment
 - Welding
