RECYCLING CENTER

Responsibilities

The Recycling Center is located at 211 N. Sussex Street and open Monday through Saturday from 8:00am to 2:00pm. Staff is on hand during open hours to monitor and maintain the Recycling Center. Staff will ensure that only accepted materials are placed into the recycling dumpsters, which eliminates recycling loads being rejected at the Materials Recycling Facility. This process maximizes our tonnage grants and lessens the tax burden on our residents.



Residents can bring their single stream recycling items to the Recycling Center. Click <u>HERE</u> for acceptable and nonacceptable items.

At no cost to Dover residents, the Recycling Center will continue to accept *White Goods* (washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc.), *Appliances* (televisions, microwaves, etc.), *Electronics* (computers, keyboards, printers, fax machine, DVD and VCR players, etc.), *Large Rigid Plastics* (large plastic toys, laundry baskets, milk crates, plastic storage containers, etc.), and *Tires* without rims a \$3.00 fee must be paid for disposal costs in the DPW office and tires with rims a \$4.00 fee must be paid for disposal costs in the DPW office prior to brining your tires into the Recycling Center.

If you cannot deliver your White Goods, Appliances, or Tires to the Recycling Center, stickers are available from the Health Dept. (37 N. Sussex Street) for these items to be placed out with your garbage.

Electronics are no longer eligible for curbside pick-up.

The New Jersey Electronics Recycling Act mandates that as of January 1, 2011, all televisions, portable desktop or personal computers and computer monitors can no longer be disposed of in the landfill and must be recycled. In addition to the mandated items above, the Recycling Center will also accept the following items at no cost:

- Desktop printers and printer/fax/copier/scanner combinations
- Computer peripherals, including keyboards, mice, hard drives, and other devices
- · Fax machines; and
- DVD players, VCR's and other video players (i.e., DVR's)

NOTE: Items that are damaged or have been stripped of their electronic components will not be accepted.

Household Hazardous Wastes may be taken to the MUA Facility located at 168 Goldmine Road in Flanders (Mt. Olive), NJ. All deliveries are by appointment only.
