WHEREAS, Millennium Strategies LLC has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Housing & Community Development Services, Inc. has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Town of Dover in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit the Housing & Community Development Services, Inc. from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that there are sufficient funds to make this award;
