Dover Recreation Department 2022 Summer Program Registration

The Dover Recreation Summer Program begins on **Monday, June 27, 2022** and ends on **Friday, August 12, 2022** at Water Works Park, 100 Princeton Avenue, Dover from 8:30am to 4:30pm Monday through Friday.



Paper applications are available at the following locations: The Dover Recreation Office (located in the lower level of Town Hall, 37 N. Sussex Street), Town Hall Lobby, and on-line at www.dover.nj.us under **Form Center** or on the Recreation Department homepage starting Monday, April 25, 2022.

All applications are to be complete when submitted in person to the Dover Recreation Office along with the following mandatory paperwork:

Proof of residency
Copy of child's birth certificate
Copy of photo ID of any person picking up your child(ren) from the park
Payment - Cash, Check or Money Order

FEES

Dover/Victory Gardens Resident Fee

The fee for the 7-week program is **\$425.00** per child *if you register starting May 2nd and before the end of business day on May 31st - that's a \$50 savings*, starting June 1, 2022 the cost is \$475.00 for the first child and \$450.00 for each additional child.

Out-of-Town Resident Fee

The fee for the 7-week program for Out-of-Town residents starts on June 1, 2022.

The cost is **\$525.00** for the first child and **\$500** for each additional child.

(Proof of address, copy of child's birth certificate, copy of photo ID of any person picking up your child(ren) from the park, and payment in the form of cash, check, or money order is required at time of registration.)

We also offer special pricing for early drop-off from 7:30am to 8:30am for **\$100** and late pick-up from 4:30 pm to 5:30 pm for **\$100** for the entire 7-week program. If you choose to do both the early drop-off and late pick-up the cost will be **\$150** for the entire 7 week program. A \$25 late fee will incur after 5:30 pm.

Please do not **drop off** your child(ren) **earlier than 8:30am**, unless you are registered for early drop-off, and any parent/guardian picking up their child(ren) **later than 4:45pm**, will incur a \$25.00 late fee unless you are registered for the late pick-up!

When rain is *forecasted*, an email will be sent to parents notifying them to bring their child(ren) to the Father Connolly Parish Center located at 37 N. Essex Street, Dover. ***Please note:*** If it rains during the day while children are at Water Works Park, children can take shelter under the pavilion and if weather conditions worsen, parents/guardians need to make arrangements to have their child(ren) picked up.

*Trips are an additional cost. See trip schedule for further information.
Please note that prices for trips have increased due to the cost of fuel.*

COVID-19 Waiver, Release, and Assumption of Risk Form

On behalf of myself, my household members, and my minor child, _____,
I hereby give permission for my child to attend the Town of Dover Recreation Summer Playground
Program at Water Works Park, 100 Princeton Avenue, Dover, NJ. My child and I are familiar with, and
knowingly and voluntarily accept, any and all risks associated with attending the summer program. I
acknowledge that my child's participation in this program is wholly voluntary.

I specifically assume all risks and hazards associated with my child's participation in the summer program
including, but not limited to, the risks associated with the COVID-19 virus and its variants. I understand
that my child will be associating with staff and other children and may contract COVID-19 or its variants
through my child's participation in the summer program. Although the staff are not taking temperatures
upon entering the summer program does not prevent the spread of COVID-19 and its variants, among
other things, the relatively long incubation period, and the fact that many infected persons are
asymptomatic. I understand and voluntarily assume the risk that my child may acquire COVID-19 or its
variants, and that COVID-19, or any variants that can subsequently be transmitted from my child to me,
my family, and members of my household.

I certify that my child is in good health, has no fever, and has no current issues that makes it unsafe for
my child to participate in the summer program, which may not have a medical professional on staff. I will
notify the Recreation Dept. and not send my child to the summer program if my child develops a fever,
illness, or tests positive for COVID-19 or any variant thereof.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, I hereby agree to waive, release, and discharge any and all claims,
causes of action, damages, and rights of any kind against the Town of Dover, Dover Recreation
Department, governing body, and all of their respective employees, agents, representatives, and volunteers
(the "Released Parties") arising from or relating in any way to any damage, injury, trauma, illness, loss,
unwanted contact, harassment, disability, dismemberment, or death that may occur to my child, me, or
my household members—whatever the cause—due to my child's participation in the summer program.
This includes, without limitation, any claim arising from the negligence of the Released Parties.

I further agree not to sue the Released Parties, and to defend and indemnify the Released Parties for all
claims, damages, losses, or expenses, including attorneys' fees, if a suit is filed concerning an injury,
illness, or death to me, my child, or my household members resulting from participation in the Town of
Dover Summer Playground Program.

Anti-Bullying Policy

Bullying is when one or more people exclude, tease, taunt, gossip, hit, kick, or put down another person with the intent to hurt another. Bullying happens when a person or group of people want to have power over another and use their power to get their way, at the expense of someone else. Bullying can also happen through cyberspace: through the use of e-mails, text messaging, instant messaging, and other less direct methods. This type of bullying can also lead to persons being hurt during or between the camp seasons and be especially hurtful when persons are targeted with meanness and exclusion.

At the Dover Recreation Summer Program, bullying is inexcusable, and we have a firm policy against all types of bullying. Our program philosophy is based on our mission statement which ensures that the children of Dover have the opportunity to enjoy a safe social, mental, and physical growth experience through a variety of activities and trips. We work together as a team to ensure that participants gain self-confidence, make new friends, and go home with great memories.

Unfortunately, persons who are bullied may not have the same potential to get the most out of their summer experience. Our policy is to address all incidents of bullying seriously and our staff shall promote communication with participants and parents so both so everyone attending may be comfortable alerting us to any problems during their summer program experience. Every person has the right to expect to have the best possible experience at camp, and by working together as a team to identify and manage bullying, we can help ensure that all children and staff have a great summer at the Dover Recreation Summer Program.

I have read the Town of Dover Summer Recreation Program Policy against bullying and will report any incidents to the Summer Program Senior Director or Directors.

SUMMER PLAYGROUND PROGRAM POLICY

The following is hereby declared to be the policy of the Town of Dover Recreation Department, hereinafter "Dover," as to its summer playground program:

1. Hours of Operation: The hours of operation of the Dover Summer Playground Program shall be 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The park will remain open on days when there are field trips with the exception of the Dorney Park trip the park will be closed. When rain is *forecasted*, parents will be notified to bring their child(ren) to the Father Connolly Parish Center located at 37 N. Essex Street, Dover. Please note that if it starts to rain, after the children are dropped off at the Water Works Park, no transportation is available to transport the children to the Father Connolly Parish Center. Parents are to make arrangements to have their child(ren) picked up at the park.

2. Eligibility: Children must be not less than 5 years old and no more than 12 years old. Dover reserves the right to request a birth certificate to confirm a child's age. Dover also reserves the right to request proof of residency. Children who are residents of Dover and Victory Gardens, have priority in the Dover Recreation Summer Playground Program. Children from other towns, not mentioned above, may be considered for entry to the program if adequate space is available.

3. Attendance: Attendance is not mandatory. Children who attend for the day must be dropped-off by a parent, guardian, or designee, and the parent, guardian, or designee must place his or her signature on a sign-in page noting the time of arrival. After a child is dropped-off, that child may not leave the playground unless picked up by a parent, guardian, or other designee. Proper identification may be required to identify the parent, guardian, or other designee, who is picking the child(ren) up during the day. **THE PARK PROGRAM CLOSSES AT 4:30 P.M. SHARP!** Children must be picked-up no later than 4:30 p.m. There is zero tolerance for lateness and any parent not picking his or her child(ren) up by 4:40 p.m. shall incur a penalty of \$25.00 for each occurrence. **An additional fee of \$100 may be paid at the time of registration to be eligible for a late pickup up by 5:30pm throughout the seven week program.* A parent or guardian may alternatively, provide written notification to Dover that they wish their children to walk to and from the program without being dropped-off. In those cases, where there is written instruction to permit walkers, the child(ren) will be allowed to attend the park program without a parent or guardian and leave at the end of the day without a parent or guardian. Such child(ren) must sign-in and sign-out at the beginning and end of the day on the Parent/Guardian Sign-in Sheet. During the day, those children who walk will not be allowed to leave the park except with special written permission by their parent or guardian.

4. Medications: Our counselors **ARE NOT ALLOWED** to administer any medications. Children requiring medication to be administered during the day shall not be permitted to enter the program, unless a parent or guardian makes alternate arrangements for the administration of medication.

5. Behavior: Dover maintains a zero tolerance policy for insubordination or inappropriate behavior in a park or on field trips. Dover reserves the right to expel any child from the playground program who is insubordinate or who behaves improperly. This shall be in the sole discretion of Dover and no refunds are given to any child who is expelled from the park program or from any trips. There is no right of appeal or hearing.

6. Electronic games and cell phones: Children are prohibited to bring electronic games to the playground program. Children may carry cell phones with the written permission of their parents. Dover will not be responsible for any electronic equipment or cell phones brought by children to the playground program that are lost, stolen or damaged. Parents who send electronic games or cell phones with their child(ren) at their sole risk.

7. Photographs: From time to time Dover takes photographs of children at play or on field trips, which they utilize in their publications or social media pages. By entering a child in the program, parents grant permission for Dover to utilize a picture containing their child's photograph for publicizing its program. **No personal information regarding your child will be published.**

Section 2. Indemnification and Hold Harmless. In consideration of my/our child’s participation in the Dover Recreation Department Summer Playground Program, I/we hereby agree that I/we will indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Dover and the Town of Dover Recreation Department, employees, agents, elected officials, and any other person officially connected with this program, from all costs and expenses, and all losses, which may be incurred by my son’s/daughter’s participation in this program, including but not being limited to, reasonable attorney’s fees.

Section 3. Consent for Photograph. I/We understand that the Dover Recreation Department takes pictures of children while at play during their summer program to promote the program and to communicate with the community the good works and fun enjoyed by our child/children in this program. I/We hereby give permission for the use of such photographs by the Town of Dover or Dover Recreation Department.

This facility will be beneficial for the Summer Program as it will accommodate the children to attend our summer program when there is a heat wave or rain forecasted.

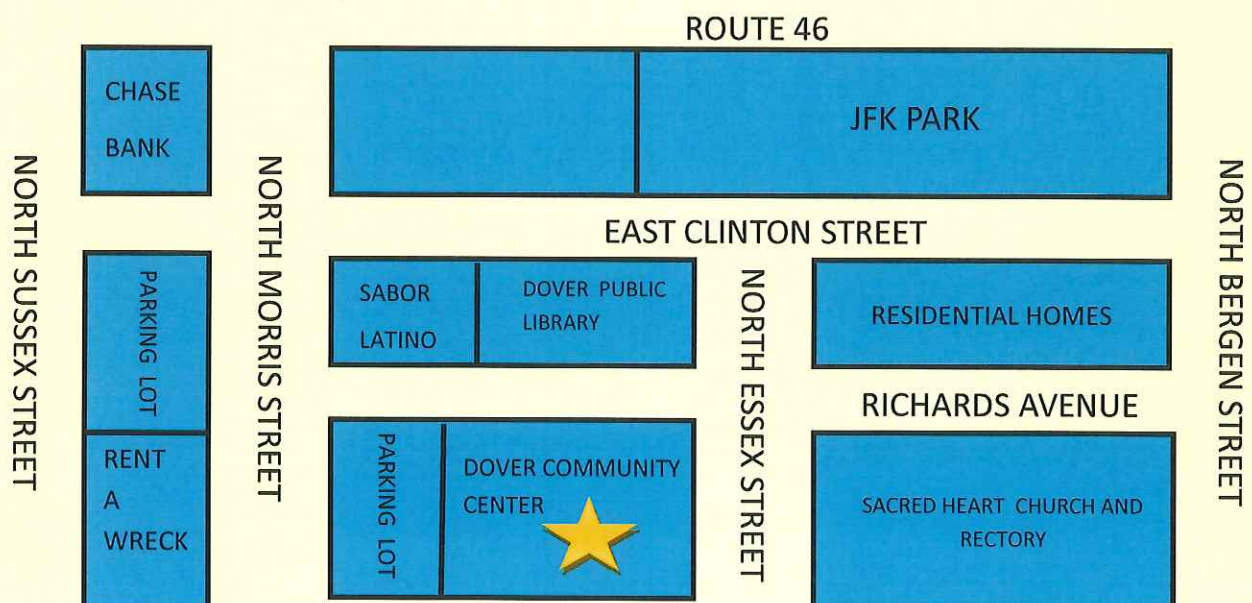
