

In response to the letter prepared by Einhorn Barbarito dated February 12, 2024 requesting waivers in reference to Planning Board Application P23-20 from Item No. 12 of the Minor Subdivision Development Checklist, which requires the installation of sidewalks and curbs in accordance with Section 236-54B and Section 236-54H, I have reviewed the following documents:

- A letter prepared by Einhorn Barbarito dated February 12, 2024 and addressed to Tamara Bross, Planning Board Secretary. This letter indicates that the owner of Block 405 Lots 4 & 5 (Christian Vega) is represented by Jason R. Rittie of Einhorn Barbarito, and that Mr. Vega consents to the request of waivers.
- 2. Land Use Application and Development Checklist for 26 Claredon Terrace & Ann Street/Beaufort Avenue.
- 3. A plan entitles "minor Subdivision Town of Dover Morris County, New Jersey Tax Map Sheet4, Block 405, Lots 4 & 5" prepared by Jaman Engineering Associates Engineers, Surveyors & Planners, dated September 29, 2023, consisting of three (3) sheets.

Based on my review of the referenced documents and aerial images, it appears that there are no existing curbs along Claredon Avenue nor are there any existing sidewalks along Claredon Terrace and Beaufort Avenue. As such, it does not appear that there is a need to install curbing and sidewalks on Claredon Terrace, although the Applicant proposes to install curbing on Ann Street and Beaufort Avenue to meet existing conditions. Therefore, I recommend that the Council move forward with granting a waiver for the installation of sidewalks and curbing on Claredon Avenue as it relates to this application.
