

**WARD No. 2**  
**Town of Dover**  
**Morris County, New Jersey**

Beginning at the most westerly corner of Ward No. 2, said point being the intersection of the municipal lines with Randolph Township, on the south, and Mine Hill Township, on the west, Morris County, and from said point of beginning running, thence

- 1) Northerly along the municipal line with Mine Hill Township, Morris County, to common corner with the municipalities of Mine Hill Township, on the west, and Wharton Borough, on the northwest, Morris County, thence
- 2) Northeasterly along the municipal line with Wharton Borough to the intersection with the centerline of North Elk Avenue, a 40-Foot Wide Right-of-Way, thence

Along the various lines with Ward No. 1, the following two (2) courses;

- 3) Southerly along said centerline of North Elk Avenue to the intersection with the centerline of West Blackwell Street, a Variable Width Right-of-Way, thence
- 4) Southeasterly and easterly along said the centerline of West Blackwell Street to the intersection with the centerline of South Morris Street, a.k.a. Morris County Route No. 643, a Variable Width Right-of-Way, thence

Along the various lines with Ward No. 3, the following six (6) courses;

- 5) Southerly along said centerline of South Morris Street, a.k.a. Morris County Route No. 643, a Variable Width Right-of-Way, to the intersection with the centerline of Byram Avenue, a 40- Foot Wide Right-of-Way, thence
- 6) Westerly along said centerline of Byram Avenue, a 40- Foot Wide Right-of-Way, to the intersection with the centerline of Second Avenue, a 40- Foot Wide Right-of-Way, thence
- 7) Northerly along said centerline of Second Avenue, a 40- Foot Wide Right-of-Way, to the intersection with the centerline of Academy Street, a 40- Foot Wide Right-of-Way, thence
- 8) Westerly and southwesterly along said centerline of Academy Street, a 40- Foot Wide Right-of-Way, to the intersection with the centerline of Madison

- Street, a 40- Foot Wide Right-of-Way, thence
- 9) Southeasterly along said centerline of Madison Street to the intersection with the centerline of Penn Avenue, a 50-Foot Wide Right-of-Way, thence
  - 10) Southwesterly along said centerline of Penn Avenue to the intersection with the municipal line with Randolph Township, Morris County, thence
  - 11) Westerly along said municipal line with Randolph Township to the point and place of beginning.
